The classroom portion of this workshop will deal with the mechanics of generating smoke within the collections system, to determine faults. This type of system testing will assist utilities with the State of California mandates to determine condition of sanitary sewers.

The hands-on portion will be in the field, utilizing the smoke generator and field personnel to determine faults within the systems.

Attendees should be prepared for outdoor changeable weather conditions. Please bring a water bottle, hat, sunscreen, gloves, sunglasses, and steel-toed boots if you have them.
